SAFETY TIP



Harvest season is a busy time on farms, but don't overlook safety in the rush. Dozens of farm workers are killed by electrocution each year as their large farm machines contact overhead power lines. Take note of electrical lines when moving equipment like portable grain augers, oversized wagons, and large combines. Make sure everyone on the farm knows the location of power lines, and keeps farm equipment at least 10 feet away from them.
